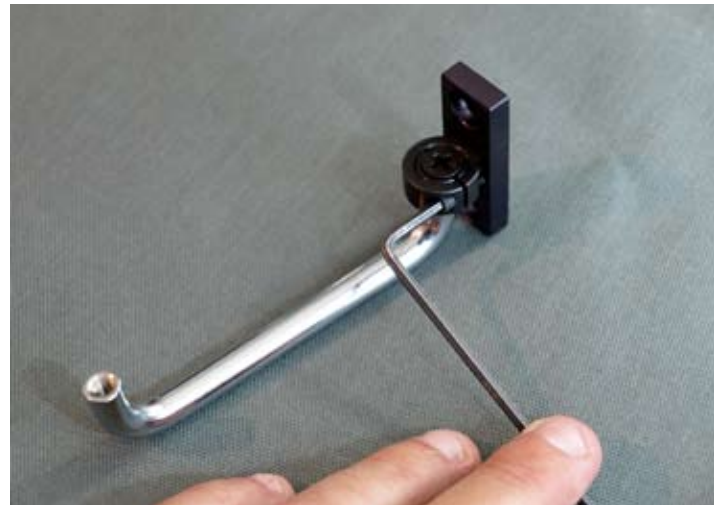
## Use and Assembly Instructions for the Rack Hook

The Chinhda Rack Hook is a very useful accessory that may be attached to any rack rail. It works equally well mounted on a free section of rack or affixed on top of a rack component.

It is necessary to disassemble the hook to gain access to the lower mounting screw hole.



Using an allen-wrench, loosen the tension adjusting screw on the collar clamp.



Using a phillips screwdriver, remove the screw securing the hook.



Completely remove the screw from the assembly.



Remove the hook from the assembly. The hook is likely to be snug, even with tension from the adjusting screw slacked off, and may require some effort to work loose.



Using an allen wrench, attach the mount to the rack rails with the supplied screws. It may be attached to an open section of rack or, as pictured here, mounted atop a piece of rack gear.



Reassemble the hook components into the mount.

Enjoy the utility of having a hook in a handy place. The hook may easily be folded back when not in use and the tension of its deployment may be adjusted with the allen screw on the clamp collar.
